Detailed Job Description:

To work within a team of Centennial Parklands volunteers assisting in the hand removal of weeds from selected areas in Centennial Park.

To utilise the on-site training provided to undertake Conservation and Land Management techniques within Centennial Parklands sites including manual weed removal, soil stimulation, preparation of waste piles for burning, construction of walking paths, and seed harvest and plant propagation activities.
