## WHAT DOES CENTENNIAL PARKLANDS PROVIDE?

All of Centennial Parklands' fields are maintained to a high standard; fully line-marked, irrigated, mown and have goal posts according to the season. Floodlighting is also available at the ES Marks Athletics Stadium and netball, basketball and tennis courts. If you need athletics equipment, it can be hired through Athletics NSW on (02) 9952 1244.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO SUPPLY AS THE HIRER?

Depending upon the sport, the hirer needs to provide goal nets with velcro or tape strapping, goal padding, corner flags and sports equipment.

## HOW DO I MAKE A CASUAL BOOKING?

All the grounds at Centennial Parklands are available for casual sporting activities. If you would like to make a booking, please call (02) 9339 6699 or email [info@cp.nsw.gov.au](mailto:info@cp.nsw.gov.au) for an application form. An application fee and a copy of your Public Liability Insurance must accompany all applications, and full payment is required before a booking can be confirmed. Please note that fields are allocated at the discretion of Centennial Parklands.

## HOW DO I MAKE A SEASONAL BOOKING?

Centennial Parklands' grounds are available for hire by application on a seasonal basis. If you wish to be on the mailing list for a seasonal application kit please phone (02) 9339 6699 or email [info@cp.nsw.gov.au](mailto:info@cp.nsw.gov.au) for an application form. All applications must be accompanied with a seasonal application fee and a copy of your Public Liability Insurance. Please note that fields are allocated at the discretion of Centennial Parklands.

## WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION DATES FOR SEASONAL BOOKINGS?

The winter sporting season in Centennial Parklands commences at the beginning of April and seasonal booking applications are due by 1 February each year. Booking confirmations for the winter season are provided to seasonal hirers by 28 February.

The summer sporting season begins at the end of September and applications are due by 1 August. Booking confirmations for the summer season are provided to seasonal hirers by 31 August.
