

The Resource Allocation Model (RAM) in 2022

For NSW public schools, the table below shows the 2022 RAM funding.

The 2022 RAM funding represents the total 2022 funding for the four equity loadings and the three base allocation loadings, a total of seven loadings. The equity loadings are socio-economic background, Aboriginal background, English language proficiency and, low-level adjustment for disability. The base loadings are location, professional learning, and per capita. Changes in school funding are the result of changes to student needs and/or student enrolments.
