







# Vehicle restrictions in Centennial Park

In order to protect park visitors, as well as the heritage and environment of Centennial Park, all large vehicles must comply with the following conditions of entry to the Park.

Vehicle restrictions apply to the height, weight, length and width of vehicles to protect - in particular - overhanging branches of the tree canopy, heritage bridges and the heritage park gates. These restrictions are enforced under the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust Regulation 2009. Fines may apply.

Some large vehicles may not require a Ranger escort in the Park. Please read the following conditions of entry relating to your vehicle.

### Large vehicles not permitted in Centennial Park at any time:

- Vehicles over 4.4 metres in height
- · Vehicles over 19 metres in length
- Vehicles over 4 metres in width

#### Permitted large vehicles restrictions:

For all vehicles requiring off-road access or traffic movements under changed traffic conditions (such as contra-flow movements), you must arrange by prior appointment a Ranger escort on 0412 718 611.

For remaining vehicles not requiring Ranger escorts, the following conditions apply:

- Grand Drive has a clearance height of 4.5 metres
- All other roads have a clearance height of 4 metres only
- Permitted large vehicles up to 19m in length and/or up to 4m in width, are to enter and exit via Randwick Gates only
- Obey all traffic control signs, especially no driving or stopping in the Cycle Lane
- 30km/h speed limit applies on all roads in Centennial Park, with the exception of Banksia Way which is strictly limited to 10km/h
- No access to Dickens Drive off Grand Drive for any vehicles 3 tonnes or over

### Specific to deliveries, suppliers and contractors:

All deliveries by suppliers and contractors for works, booked events, film shoots or activities within the Park must have confirmed arrangements with the project coordinator prior to day of intended entry.

## **FACT SHEET**

#### Bus zone locations

Bus zones in Centennial Park are indicated. These must be used in order to safely park, to unload and load passengers to the footpath side of the roadway. Please note, all large vehicles must enter and exit Centennial Park through Randwick Gates.

Bus Zone 1 – Parkes Drive Adjacent to Banksia Way

- Parklands Office
- · Centennial Parklands Dining

Bus Zone 2 – Loch Avenue South of Grand Drive

- Parade Grounds 8, 9, 10
- · Loch Avenue South Area

**Bus Zone 3** – Dickens Drive Adjacent to Fly Casting Pond

- The Education Precinct
  - · The Learning Centre

**Bus Zone 4 –** Parkes Drive Near Duck Pond (Mon - Fri only)

- Mission Fields 5, 6
- · Lachlan Reserve
- McKay Field 4
- Church Grounds

Bus Zone 5 - Martin Road Outside the Park
