Rose robin. An autumn and winter nomad.

Eastern yellow robin. A breeding resident.

Jacky-winter. Once common, now occasional.

Golden whistler. A regular nomad in autumn and winter.

Rufous whistler. A regular breeding summer migrant.

Black-faced monarch. An irregular passage migrant.

Leaden flycatcher. An irregular passage migrant.

Satin flycatcher. A rare passage migrant.

Restless flycatcher. Once regular, now rare.

Rufous fantail. A rare passage migrant.

Grey fantail. A regular autumn and winter visitor.

Willy wagtail. A common breeding resident.

Clamorous reed warbler. Once common, now in less numbers.

Little grassbird. Once common, now rare.
