Stage 1 Geography

This inquiry-based excursion provides children with the opportunity to discover the features of Centennial Parklands. They will complete fieldwork activities to collect primary data via hands on activities and games in relation to the built and natural features of the park.

The excursion activities will include:

- Dip netting in the ponds
- Bush walking and the mud-mapping of Lachlan Swamp
- Weather and seasons survey
