Centennial Parklands is central to Australia's vibrant filming and entertainment industry, hosting over 170 commercial film and photography shoots a year. CBD we offer the industry a vast range of

GRASSLAND & OPEN SPACE AREAS

FEDERATION VALLEY

Federation Valley is a beautiful setting housing the historic Federation Pavilion. This site was the location for the bungalow scene of the major feature film The Great Gatsby.







CHURCH GROUNDS

Church Grounds is a wide open space with city views , adjacent to a large pond. It provides easy access and suitable space for infrastructure. An ideal location for major productions.

LACHLAN RESERVE

Lachlan Reserve is home to tall paperbark trees with walking tracks and various native ferns. An ideal location for an enchanted forest scene.

SOUTH WEST PADDOCK

South West Paddock is an open grassed area that is deliberately maintained in a naturalistic (unkempt) manner and displays a blanket of long grass.

₩ WOODLAND AREAS

PINE GROVE

A thick cluster of pines with a bed of pine needles on the ground. Positioned in the centre of Centennial Park, Pine Grove offers great light exposure.

ASH PADDOCK

The tree grove at Ash Paddock is a popular area of sloping grounds with pines – a site that was once converted into the slopes of the Canadian Rockies for a television commercial.







Pine Grove has been used for movies, television shows and (in this case) an Indian Spice television commercial.



ONDS & WATERWAYS

Centennial Parklands is home to picturesque and iconic ponds, covering 26 hectares.

LILY POND

Lily Pond is sandstone edged, with a central island as a refuge and nesting habitat for aquatic birds.

BUSBYS POND

Busbys Pond has a reed-fringed shore, lilies and large nesting islands. It is one of the most scenic areas in the park particularly at sunrise and sunset.

The Parklands has a significant horticultural history and is often described as Sydney's best example of a Victorian-era park.

COLUMN GARDEN & ROSE GARDEN

Column Garden and Rose Garden are the centrepieces of Centennial Park's formal gardens. A very popular area for wedding ceremonies and fashion shoots for magazines such as *Harpers Bazaar*, as well as reality shows like *Farmer Wants a Wife*.







COTTAGES

Centennial Park also features two heritage cottages. These elegant federation houses exhibit typical features of their period with expansive views of the Park.

MT STEEL

Mt Steel, situated near Moore Park Golf, is a hidden treasure offering panoramic views of the city skyline. It is one of the only remaining sandhills that formerly dominated this part of Sydney.

SANDSTONE RIDGE

Sandstone Ridge runs along the northern edge of Centennial Park, with rocky outcrops lining a semi-wild area.







ROADWAYS, PATHWAYS & TRACKS

An advantage of filming at the Parklands is that we can often accommodate parking near your film site and we can also facilitate large unit base parking such as at Kippax area in Moore Park – a convenient option if you are filming in the CBD or neighbouring Surry Hills.

GRAND DRIVE

Grand Drive – the first public suburban drive in Sydney - is the main circular road in Centennial Park. Cars, cyclists and horse riders use this roadway and its adjacent pathways daily.

LOCH AVENUE & MUSGRAVE AVENUE

Loch Avenue South and Musgrave Avenue can both be closed off and used exclusively for shoots, with minimal impact on the visiting public. Musgrave Avenue has proven to be ideal for car-based commercials requiring a closed roadway.

SNAKE BANK

Snake Bank has an almost 'tropical' feel, providing a palm tree-lined track alongside a large pond. This site has proved popular for television commercials including one with an elephant walking down the track!









SPORTING FACILITIES

MOORE PARK GOLF

Moore Park Golf is the closest public access golf course to the Sydney CBD, boasting convenience, accessibility and spectacular views of the city skyline.

CENTENNIAL PARKLANDS EQUESTRIAN CENTRE

For productions that include horses, the Centennial Parklands Equestrian Centre is the ideal environment - heritage stables pavilions, a large covered dressage arena and a separate equestrian ground as well as a 3.6km equestrian track in Centennial Park. Horses are also available for hire.



ES MARKS ATHLETICS FIELD

ES Marks Athletics Field in Moore Park has an international-standard synthetic running track, plus seating for up to 5,000 people - ideal for that sporting scene or athletics commercial.







BELVEDERE AMPHITHEATRE

Belvedere Amphitheatre overlooks Federation Valley and has beautiful views of the Parklands. It plays host to the popular outdoor Moonlight Cinema over summer and is also a perfect site for filming theatrical plays or holding a film premiere.

CENTENNIAL PARKLANDS DINING

The award-winning Centennial Parklands Dining is located in the heart of Centennial Park. It features a takeaway kiosk, table-service cafe, and Wine Room. Other food and beverage businesses operate throughout the Park.
